The formula: Jesus is His own authority.

We need to be clear on two things...

First: We need to be clear on the \_\_\_\_\_ of the sixth commandment.

The sixth commandment teaches the \_\_\_\_\_ of life.

Second: We need to be clear on Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ of the sixth commandment to where we live life.

To live in relationship with the living God means that we need to value people like God values people.

Bottom Line: When we live in relationship with the living God who we are isn't the main issue.

5:27-32: We need to be clear about two things...

Second: We need to be clear on Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ of the seventh commandment to where we live life.

We're bombarded with temptation all day long. What Jesus is talking about is our response.
